**Pop-Up Holiday Shop, Thursday December 2nd!**



**LIVING NATIVITY Sunday, December 12<sup>th</sup> Mark your calendars:** Such a worthwhile event here at CPC. On Central's Maple Street lawn, where live animals and costumed actors will re-enact the first Christmas. Join the Church and Summit Community for this special time together. The Nativity will run from 4:30 to 5:30 p.m. outside.

**Inclement Weather:** We escaped November without any winter storms this year. I do not know if we will be as fortunate through December. We do follow what the Summit School's decisions for closings, delays, and early dismissals if winter weather causes concern for everyone's safety. You would be notified by text alerts, emails, and posting to our school website [cpc-school.org](http://cpc-school.org). Most decisions are made the night before but can be deferred to the next morning. You will hear from us as soon as we know. If Summit schools have a delayed opening, we open at 10:30 am. There may be times when the decision is made to open, but road conditions may be questionable. Please use your best judgement. The safety of you and your children is of utmost importance.

**REGISTRATION for September 2022 School Year:** For all our current families, applications for the next age group will be automatically sent to you the beginning of January. All registration is done by mail. **For the 2022-2023 school year, if you have a younger child who will be eligible for the Nursery School classes, or if you are considering a second year for your child in a 4-year-old program, please let the office know so an application can be mailed to you.
